The mission of BridgeSTEAM programs is to **empower**, **support**, and **inspire** girls to pursue a career in STEAM and to become the world leaders of the future by providing them with the right tools, opportunities, and hands-on activities through our free educational programs.

Through fun, hands-on activities and challenges that will excite and expose girls to the fields of STEAM, we aim to introduce them to STEAM careers.

This year, 2023, was the third year of the initiative and 5 BridgeSTEAM programs took place across Cyprus:

- April 22 & 23 Youth Makerspace Larnaka for Ukrainian-displaced women 18+
- May 20 & 21 Amdocs Cyprus, Limassol for Ukrainian-displaced girls 14-17
- September 2 & 3 PwC Experience Center, Nicosia for girls 17-18
- October 14 & 15 PwC Experience Center, Nicosia for girls 14-16
- December 9 & 10 Youth Makerspace Larnaka for girls 14-16

DETAILS ON THE ACTIVITIES

Coding Workshops

The focus of the BridgeSTEAM 2023 programs was to cultivate coding skills for the participants. As such, a **7-hour workshop was offered** during each program by a team of trainers focused on coding.









Discussions with Women Role Models

Last year's evaluation from the participants has shown that the discussions with the women role-models has been one of the most impactful parts of the program, as it gave the opportunity to the girls to hear directly from women who have made it in male-dominated STEAM fields and ask them various questions about their career and professional path. As such, these discussions could not have been omitted from the 2023 programs as well. A total of fourteen women role models were part of the BridgeSTEAM 2023 Programs.









Each role model shared details of her academic and professional background with the participants, discussed her duties and responsibilities at her current position, shared any challenges she faced during her journey with the ultimate goal of inspiring the girls and most importantly to make them more familiar with careers that are considered "male-dominated".









Through the discussions / presentations, the participants were informed about career alternatives for the STEAM fields and expressed their interest by asking questions and clarifications. After the presentations, the participants had the opportunity to further network with the speakers by asking more questions about their career. The participation of women role-models was voluntary.



Workshop for the 17 Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations

A 1.5-hour workshop was offered on the 17 Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations. The participants were informed about the SDGs and their objectives and have worked in teams on analyzing innovative inventions that tackle one global challenge.



Career Counseling and opportunities in STEAM fields

Another aspect that was evident from last year's programs was the need for a targeted workshop on **Career Counseling** and what opportunities there are in STEAM fields. As such, the four BridgeSTEAM programs that addressed girls aged 14-16 and 14-17 included a 1.5-hour workshop titled Academic studies' options and career prospects in STEAM fields.



The workshop was led by Marigeorgia Voskaridou, a licensed career counselor, and its goal was to empower the girls on their future options by analyzing the most prominent fears about their futures and helping them decide what they want to follow.



Public Speaking Skills

Similarly, the program that addressed girls aged 17-18 years old included a 1.5-hour workshop titled **Development of Public Speaking Skills** led by Leonidas Alexandrou, a life coach and youth mentor. The workshop aimed to unlock the potential of participants in developing their presentation and public



speaking skills, especially considering that they are at a stage before or starting their academic studies for which, these skills are crucial.



Discussion on Gender Equality

Finally, at the end of each 2-day program, the Girls in STEAM Academy team initiated a conversation focusing on Goal #5 - Gender Equality and invited the participants to engage in a constructive and judgment-free discussion around the topic. The discussion focused on topics such as gender and equality issues, empowerment, as well as some powerful initiatives in Cyprus that promote this goal, with the support of educational videos.







BridgeSTEAM Program for Ukranian displaced women and girls

In collaboration with the CUTing Edge (An American Space) of Cyprus University of Technology and the U.S. Embassy in Cyprus, Girls in STEAM Academy offered two programs for displaced women and girls from the Ukraine in April and May 2023.

NETWORKING

2023 marked the third year of activities for Girls in STEAM Academy and as such, it was an important milestone for the initiative. Having completed a total of 11 BridgeSTEAM programs throughout the period 2021 – 2023, with 161 graduates belonging in the alumnae network, the initiative looks into the future to implement more programs and engage and impact even more girls in Cyprus.

But the BridgeSTEAM programs are just one aspect of the initiative. Throughout the whole year, the the team been working relentlessly to collect opportunities for the alumnae that would keep them engaged in STEAM-related activities even after the completion of the programs. Networking is one of the important aspects of the activities activities at Girls in STEAM Academy. Recognizing the immense value of **connections and collaborations**, we have focused on building a robust network that not only supports our alumnae but also fosters opportunities for **mentorship**, **internships**, **and collaborative projects**. This network includes professionals from various STEAM fields, educational institutions, and industry leaders who are committed to empowering young women in these disciplines.

Amdocs Cyprus Webinar "Building bridges in the labour market"

On Saturday, February 11, 2023, Girls in STEAM Academy in collaboration with **Amdocs Cyprus** organized the webinar "Building bridges in the labour market" for the graduates of our programs. The purpose of the webinar was to provide guidance on creating a CV, tips for successful interviews and developing a LinkedIn profile. Amdocs Cyprus provided a valuable opportunity to our graduates with skills that will be especially useful for them in the future.





SignalGeneriX Experience

SignalGeneriX, a leading high-tech research and development company, encouraging more girls to develop an interest in careers in science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics, organised a study visit at their offices, with graduates of the Girls In STEAM Academy programs on the 12th of April 2023. A total of 12 girls that participated were given the opportunity to participate in educational workshops and have interactive experience with real electronics research and development projects, which are in progress.

Objective of the workshops:

- To allow girls hands on experience in electronics, robotics and artificial intelligence.
- To have contact with reputable scientists in the field, to exchange opinions and to be informed about the various opportunities in the technology sector, before choosing their professional path.
- To discover the perspective of teamwork by networking with industry experts and collaborating for optimal outcomes that impact the lives of millions of people.



Specifically, during the day, the girls were challenged to participate in workshops of:

- Microelectronics and Hardware Development (Hardware) using a microscope and an automatic robot, for welding electronic circuit boards.
- Rapid Prototyping and Design in SolidWorks of a prototype to scale and 3D printing and laser engraving.
- Software Development Generating interactive code for sensors.

Job shadowing activities in Cyprus

For a second year, Girls in STEAM Academy established collaborations with various companies and educational institutions in Cyprus, which offered several job shadowing opportunities for the alumnae during the summer of 2023. Collaborators include PwC Cyprus, Cocoon Creations, The Workshop, biobank.cy, Domostatica and Charalambides Christis Ltd.











A total of six BridgeSTEAM graduates have taken part in these job shadowing activities in the aforementioned companies in the summer of 2023.



Girls go Circular webinar - Junior Achievement Cyprus

On the 20th of July 2023, Junior Achievement Cyprus organized a webinar for the Girls in STEAM Academy alumnae focusing on the "Girls go Circular" project. The Girls Go Circular Project aims to equip 40,000 schoolgirls aged 14-19 across Europe with digital and entrepreneurial skills by 2027 through an online learning program about the circular economy.

The online learning platform developed in the framework of the project - the "Circular Learning Space" - offers students the option of choosing between different learning modules on topics like e-waste, climate change, food, or robotics. These modules are based on a learning-by-doing approach, transferring knowledge and skills through an interactive, challenge-based structure.

In our commitment to amplify the reach and impact of Girls in STEAM Academy, we actively engaged in various promotional activities throughout the year. Our team members served as esteemed panelists at various festivals, sharing insights and championing the empowerment of girls in STEAM. Our dedicated booth hosted an engaging experiment, allowing visitors, especially children, to extract their own DNA and partake in a captivating dry ice demonstration, in collaboration with Science Communication - SciCo Cyprus.



Furthermore, the co-founders delivered an enlightening presentation on the vital role of equality in geek culture, emphasizing that the geek culture is intrinsically focusing on social justice and, therefore, gender equality, that is in turn reflected into Comic Con.

The Cyprus Comic Con, boasting an impressive attendance of over 20,000 people during both days, provided a substantial platform to showcase our initiative. The interactive nature of our activities and the booth thoughtprovoking presentation contributed to the event's success but significantly enhanced the visibility of Girls in STEAM Academy. This exposure serves as a pivotal step in bridging the gap between science and popular culture, making our initiative more accessible and appealing to a diverse audience. The enthusiastic response from Comic Con attendees underscores the resonance of our mission and the potential for broadening our impact on future generations interested in STEAM disciplines.





Youth TechFest

The Youth Tech Fest Cyprus 2023 was organised on the 18th of November 2023 at the main campus of the University of Nicosia. Run under the auspices of the Ministry of Education in Cyprus, the Youth Tech Fest Cyprus was a celebration of children's passion for all things technology, science, art, environment and entrepreneurship. The event is also the recognition of educators' efforts to prepare literate and creative citizens for technology-driven society.



Girls in STEAM Academy's co-founder Anastasia Liopetriti was invited to the event as a panelist for the panel "STEAM for All", where she had the opportunity to reflect with the audience and with other panelists about making the STEAM sectors accessible to all, regardless of gender, ethnicity, or identity.

With an invitation by Geekotopos, Girls in STEAM Academy was present with a live recording of an episode of the SheSpeaks podcast. The episode was hosted by a 2022 program graduate, Mariami Kokkinou, who welcomed dr. Myrtani Pieri, Associate Professor - Human Physiology at the University of Nicosia, BA in Biology, PhD in Human Physiology and Genetics, and together had a fruitful discussion.





Madame Figaro Women of the Year Award nominees

ALUMNAE NETWORK BENEFITS

Each participant who has completed the BridgeSTEAM program automatically joins the Girls in STEAM Academy Alumnae Network, which offers the following benefits:

- Newsletter and news The alumnae are constantly receiving updates for activities and other programs, in addition to the quarterly newsletter with STEAM-related news, events, and opportunities.
- Job shadowing activity Continuing this activity from the two previous years, in the summer of 2024, participants will have the opportunity to participate in job shadowing activity programs at various companies and educational institutions in Cyprus that are relevant with STEAM fields. The aim of this initiative is to enable the participants to experience what it is like to work in a professional environment of various professions and to network with professionals in the field.
- Scholarship and educational opportunities They will be informed about scholarship opportunities at Universities in Cyprus, the EU and the US.
- Opportunities abroad They will be informed about the programs abroad, such as the TechGirls program and will be supported through their applications. TechGirls is an exchange program organized by the US State Department, taking place in the US every summer followed by communitybased projects in the participants' home communities. It is addressed to young girls that are interested in technology and STEAM.
- SheSpeaks Podcast They will have the opportunity to be part of the SheSpeaks podcast show by Girls in STEAM Academy in the role of the presenter, and meet and interview women role models in STEAM fields.
- Benefit from other partnerships The team of Girls in STEAM Academy will be constantly informed about various other opportunities and will share the benefits of their partnerships with the Alumnae network.

TechGirls Program



Natalia Andreou and Christina Kakathymis, graduates of the 2022 BridgeSTEAM programs, were chosen to represent Cyprus to the TechGirls program in the United States, in the summer of 2023. Over 100 girls from various countries all over the world spent two weeks in the United States, in partnership with Virginia Tech University. Participants engaged in an interactive technology and computer camp among other things like study visits to NASA. The program is funded by the U.S. Department of State, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs.

Natalia and Christina attended the first BridgeSTEAM program 2023 in Nicosia, where they presented their experience to the program participants and inspired them to apply for next year's program as well.




